Chapter 5.04, Section .060 entitled "Hours of Business" is hereby 22 amended by adding thereto the following: 23 24 a) Hours of Operation. For businesses located within the City of Cranston whose 25 hours of operation are subject to this Chapter, the hours of operation listed on their initial 26 application and approved by the committee may not be increased until voted upon by the 27 Committee on Safety Services after a public hearing for which advance written notice has 28 been given. Written notice of the date, time and place of the public hearing and proposed 29 change in hours of operation shall be sent by regular mail to all owners of real property 30 whose property is located in or within not less than two hundred (200) feet of the 31 business seeking to increase its hours of operation. The cost of said notice and radius 32 map shall be paid by the business seeking to increase its hours of operation. 33 34 No shops, store or other place of trade or entertainment in the city, excepting 35 licensed taverns, shall be kept open between [1:00 a.m. and 4:00 a.m.] 10 pm and 6 am; 36 provided, however, that for sufficient cause shown to the [police] Safety Services & 37 Licensing committee any shop, store or other place of trade or entertainment in the city, 38 except one holding an alcoholic beverage license, may be granted a license to keep open 39 for a longer time upon payment of the license fee required. 40 41 Businesses who currently operate between the hours of 10 pm to 1 a.m. at the 42 time of adoption of this section may continue with their current hours of operation, unless 43 otherwise modified by the Safety Services & Licensing Committee for cause. 44

B) All night operation between the hours of 10 pm and 6 am. Any business may 46 apply for an all night license permitting operation for specific hours between the hours of 47 10 pm to 6 am upon a showing of public convenience and necessity after a public hearing 48 before the Safety Services & Licensing Committee after having given notice to abutters 49 as set forth above and by publication once a week for three (3) consecutive weeks in a 50 daily or weekly newspaper published and circulated in the City Nothing contained in this 51 section shall exempt any business for notice and publication requirements for an all night 52 53 license. 54 An applicant who has been denied a license to keep open all night cannot reapply 55 for the license within a period of six months from the date of denial unless there is a 56 substantial change of circumstances as evidenced by an affidavit signed by the applicant. 57 58 Section 2.
