15	WHEREAS, Matthew Josefson was serving as a member of the Cranston Police
16	Department in the rank of Sergeant; and
17	
18	<i>WHEREAS</i> , Sergeant Josefson was demoted by then Colonel Palombo on November 20,
19	2013 from the rank of Sergeant to the rank of Patrolman; and
20 21	WHEREAS, the assessment of the Cranston Rhode Island Police Department for the
21	period 2014 – 2015 was conducted by the Rhode Island State Police pursuant to a request by
23	Mayor Fung; and
23	Mayor Tung, and
25	WHEREAS, in late July 2015, the Rhode Island State Police made public a partially
26	redacted version of their Assessment of the Cranston Police Department; and
27	
28	WHEREAS, as part of that Assessment, section 8 of the Report, which includes both
29	factual findings and conclusions from pages 83 through 130, addresses the state police
30	assessment of the handling of the demotion of Sergeant Josefson; and
31	
32	WHEREAS, in the Assessment by the State Police, the State Police reviewed all then
33	pending charges against Sergeant Josefson and concluded that the charges lacked factual and
34	reasonable basis, lacked documentation, and lacked quantifiable evidence. Principal among those
35	charges was the assertion that Sergeant Josefson violated a ban on use of recording devices by
36	police officers at the Cranston Police station. The State Police found that the policy or rule and
37 38	enacting such a ban had never been properly adopted or circulated to members of the Cranston Police force; and
30 39	Police force, and
40	WHEREAS, the Cranston City Council reviewed the State Police Assessment report in
41	its entirety and held a special meeting of the City Council to question the Mayor concerning the
42	findings of this report and Assessment; and

46	WHEREAS, the Cranston City Council accepts as true the findings of the Rhode Island
47	State Police Assessment that in essence Sergeant Josefson was improperly demoted from his
48	position as Sergeant and specifically finds that this demotion was unfair and unjust; and
49	
50	WHEREAS, on August 27, 2014, the Rhode Island State Police discussed the Josefson
51	situation in detail with Mayor Fung and recommended he be restored immediately to the rank of
52	sergeant, yet Mayor Fung has not acted to right an obvious wrong,";
53	
54	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council is requesting Mayor
55	Fung to immediately restore Officer Matthew Josefson to the position of Sergeant in the
56	Cranston Police Department.
