22	SECTION 1: Title 8.44.010 entitled "Health and Safety" "Smoking" Smoke-free

28	"Athletic and recreational facility" means any athletic or recreational facility including,					
29	but not limited to, any playing field, ballfield, basketball court, tennis court, soccer field, or					
30	playground which is owned or operated by the city.

31	"Municipal building" means all buildings except school buildings, owned or leased by the					
32	city, including outside areas within twenty (20) feet of same.					
33	"Person" means any person or persons including, but not limited to, contract or other					
34	workers on municipal buildings, city employees, and the public at large.					
35	"Tobacco product usage" means the smoking or use of any substance or item which					
36	contains tobacco, including, but not limited to, cigarettes, cigars, pipes, chewing tobacco,					
37 38	<b>snus, smokeless tobacco</b> or other smoking tobacco or material, or having in one's possession a lighted cigarette cigar nine or other substance containing tobacco, including E cigarettes and

41	"Electronic Smoking Device" means an electronic and/or battery-operated device, the use of					
42	which may resemble smoking, that can be used to deliver an inhaled dose of nicotine or other
