Fung, Mayor 17 18 19 It is ordained by the City Council of the City of Cranston as follows: 20 Section 1: Chapter 2.40.030 of the Code of the City of Cranston, 2005, entitled 21 22 "Administration and Personnel" - Salary of Mayor is hereby amended by deleting the 23 following: 24 25 [Pursuant to Section 5.06] of the charter, the annual compensation of the mayor is fixed as 26 follows: January 1, 1999 thru December 31, 1999 \$75,000.00 January 1, 2000 thru December 31, 2000 76,875.00 Increased by 2 ½% to January 1, 2001 thru December 31, 2001 Increased by 2 ½% to 78,796.00 January 1, 2002 thru December 31, 2002 Increased by 2 ½% to 80,765.00 27 And adding thereto the following: 28 29 2.04.030 - Salary of mayor. 30 31 32 Pursuant to Section 5.06 of the Charter, the annual compensation of the Mayor is fixed as 33 follows: 1. That commencing January 4, 2021, the annual salary of the Mayor shall be 34 \$125,000.00 \***\$105,000** per annum. 35 2. \*That in each successive year said salary shall be increased by a 2.5% cost of 36 living adjustment for each year that current office holder is mayor. 37 38 3. Upon the election of any subsequent Mayor the salary shall commence at \$125.000.00 \*\$105.000 and be subject to the same cost of living adjustments 39 as set forth in paragraph 2. 40
