19 **WHEREAS, in the City of Cranston,**

20 • The City is in need of acquisition, improvement, renovation and repair of fire and public
21 safety equipment, including but not limited to \$8,000,000 for such projects; and

22 • In order that a question be placed before the qualified electors of the City of Cranston at
23 the general election to be held on November 3, 2026, or, if so determined by the City Council, at
24 a special city-wide election, other than a primary, held on a date to be determined by resolution
25 or order of the City Council, seeking approval from the qualified electors authorizing the City to
26 issue bonds and notes in an amount not to exceed \$8,000,000, passage of legislation by the
27 Rhode Island General Assembly during its 2026 session is essential; and

28 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT,** the Honorable City Council:

29 1. Endorses legislative action by the General Assembly that permits the aforementioned
30 city-wide ballot question; and

31 2. This resolution shall take effect upon passage and the City Clerk is directed to certify
32 the same and transmit it to the Speaker of the House, Senate President, Governor and all State
33 Senators and Representatives representing Cranston requesting passage of the necessary special
34 legislation during the 2026 session of the General Assembly of the State of Rhode Island to
35 further authorize the City of Cranston to issue said Bonds and Notes.
