19 **WHEREAS**, in the City of Cranston,

20 • The City is in need of design, construction, repair, rehabilitation and improvement of
21 streets, sidewalks and bridges, including paving, drainage, traffic control devices, road
22 maintenance equipment, safety improvements and landscaping, including but not limited to
23 \$8,000,000 for such projects; and

24 • In order that a question be placed before the qualified electors of the City of Cranston at
25 the general election to be held on November 3, 2026, or, if so determined by the City Council, at
26 a special city-wide election, other than a primary, held on a date to be determined by resolution
27 or order of the City Council, seeking approval from the qualified electors authorizing the City to
28 issue bonds and notes in an amount not to exceed \$8,000,000, passage of legislation by the
29 Rhode Island General Assembly during its 2026 session is essential; and

30 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, the Honorable City Council:

31 1. Endorses legislative action by the General Assembly that permits the aforementioned
32 city-wide ballot question; and

33 2. This resolution shall take effect upon passage and the City Clerk is directed to certify
34 the same and transmit it to the Speaker of the House, Senate President, Governor and all State
35 Senators and Representatives representing Cranston requesting passage of the necessary special
36 legislation during the 2026 session of the General Assembly of the State of Rhode Island to
37 further authorize the City of Cranston to issue said Bonds and Notes.
